- The Tournaments are run by **Durham City Chess Club** and **Durham County Chess Association (DCCA)** and are open to all junior players (under 18 on 31st August 2018).
- Each tournament will have 5 or 6 rounds. The time control is 10 minutes plus 5 seconds per move for each player. They are not knock-out tournaments so all players will compete throughout the afternoons.
- All juniors are welcome – no previous tournament experience is required.
- **Teams:** A team consists of 4 players, normally from the same school or club. However, individuals can enter and teams will be formed on the day.
- **Prizes:** Chess book prizes will be awarded.
- **Registration** from 1pm and **Round 1 will start around 1.15pm**. The events including prize-giving, should finish before 5pm.
- **Entry fee: £6 per player (additional siblings £4)**. Pay on day but **register in advance**.
- **Closing date for entries: Wednesday 31st October for Individual Tournament**
Wednesday 28th November for Team Tournament
- Light refreshments (tea, coffee, juice, snacks) will be on sale, but please feel free to bring your own.
